



JACK AND THE BEANSTALK **PRODUCTION ADVICE**

Jack and the Beanstalk takes place at the Kenton Theatre, New Street, Henley on Thames. Please ensure you are on time for the DRESS REHEARSAL, we need to do the necessary Health and Safety briefing and any hold ups will only prolong the rehearsal when I am conscious that everyone is in a hurry to go off and do other things. Late arrivals = late finish!

NB the new arrival times for the PERFORMANCES, - the children will need to arrive in make up as we are no longer offering this service (except for Seniors).

There are no spare shoes available and each child **MUST** arrive with the correct footwear.

When you arrive at the theatre, use the STAGE DOOR to the left of the building as you look at it from the street. The children will be in Dressing Rooms 1 – 4. Your child's arrival AND departure must be noted upon arrival (either Dave or Milly, Stage Managers) at the stage door.

Head to your dressing room :

Dressing Room 1 – SENIORS

Dressing Room 2 – BOYS (once the chorus boys are changed, they can join their class in correct rooms upstairs)

Dressing Room 3 (upstairs) – Class B and C

Dressing Room 4 (upstairs) – Class A

Get your child settled in with their belongings, ready in their costume, check if they need to visit the bathroom, and then leave as promptly as possible.

Bring snacks and WATER, and perhaps some amusement that is quiet and clean – colouring, quiz book, cards etc. No electronic toys.

The performance should last approximately 2 hours and 10 minutes, including the enforced 20 minute interval. The first show might be longer, but as everyone improves, we can reduce this slightly.

Collection of your child is from the Theatre auditorium (we are not able to block the fire exit at the Stage Door passageway). Please wait until your child comes down to the stage where they will be signed out for you to take home. NB the class will appear as a whole so it is not possible to rush one child ahead of another.

Do not take costumes home as these are shared with the alternate colour group. Make sure you have correct footwear and any costume extras you have been asked to supply. These (and all your belongings) go home with you after each performance, BUT NOT THE COSTUME!

At the end of the production, most lost property will be kept and brought to the start of next term. We do not keep the odd socks and small items.
